## **Words with "Sound Targets"**

You will see on your treatment sheets samples of words that utilize different parts of the tongue. An example is the "ch" sound and "J" sounds that use the sides of the tongue, while the "T,D,N,L" sounds are produced by using the tip of the tongue.

Please find additional words here that produce two sound targets (see below).

Add these to your exercises in your treatment sheets as you see fit.

Words that have two "sound targets" per word, so you may have 20 words with 40 targets. The following words target the alveolar area (for tip of the tongue elevation), the front palatal part (side tongue elevation), posterior palatal part (also for sides of the tongue elevation), velar part for tongue-soft palate contact.
